The Illinois Geological Society and the Illinois State Geological Survey are co-hosting the Eastern Section AAPG annual meeting at the IHotel and Conference Center on the University of Illinois campus in Champaign, Illinois October 24<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>, 2022. This is a prime opportunity to interface and network with industry leaders in Energy Storage, Reservoir Characterization and Modeling, Efficient Hydrocarbon Recovery and Production Techniques in both Conventional and Unconventional reservoirs, and Critical Mineral Exploration and Development in the United States. As the theme implies, **ENERGY FOR ALL**, recognizes that all facets of the energy spectrum are required to shape the energy future of the United States in a sustainable, productive, and innovative path. To remain a world-leader in energy technology is part of the rationale for this conference.

Program events includes oral and poster presentations, an extensive core workshop, short courses, energy storage and critical mineral workshops and a field trip to southern Illinois to examine mineralization associated with Hicks Dome. This is an ultra-mafic complex that hosts carbonatites, rocks which host rare earth elements (REEs). Elements which are part of the national energy security drive for discovery and characterization. A Student Expo will be held on Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> for students to present research posters, receive training, and allow industry and governmental organizations to interview students for future potential internships. Short courses may include critical topics such as completion and stimulation techniques, natural gas storage best practices, and reservoir characterization of Mississippian sandstones within the Illinois Basin.
